

# SENATE PAGE PROGRAM

## (An opportunity to work on Parliament Hill)

Each year, fifteen university students from across Canada are selected to participate in the Senate Page Program. If you are an undergraduate student who is bilingual in both official languages, you are invited to apply to be part of an interesting and dynamic program that will enrich your university experience. Year after year, the Senate Page Program provides eligible students with the exciting and stimulating environment that places you at the heart of the Canadian parliamentary system, while being provided with a salary to help support you as you advance your university studies.

### REQUIREMENTS

- Candidates must be enrolled as full-time students in their first undergraduate degree. Be a full-time student pursuing their first undergraduate degree willing to live in the National Capital Region, and pursue their studies in one of the four universities
- Not have previous experience as a Page on Parliament Hill
- Oral communications at an advanced level in both of Canada's official languages
- Demonstrate of the Senate's institutional competencies in their cover letter

### ASSET QUALIFICATIONS

- Experience in participating and/or coordinating various extracurricular/volunteer activities;
- Experience in providing administrative support
- Awards and other recognitions
