

HOUSE OF COMMONS PAGE PROGRAM

Each year, approximately 40 students are selected from high schools and CEGEPs across Canada to come and work as Pages in the House of Commons.

Pages are given the rare opportunity to watch the House of Commons in action, to learn the workings of Parliament from a unique perspective and to meet other young people from all parts of the country.

REQUIREMENTS

- be graduating from a secondary school or a CEGEP (with no academic interruptions) and beginning full-time university studies in September 2020
- Students who maintain a minimum average of 80%
- be able to orally communicate fluently in both official languages, as evaluated by the House of Commons
- must be accepted in a full-time program at a university in the National Capital Region
- must possess superior interpersonal skills
- show sound judgment, be reliable, tactful and courteous and
- demonstrate an interest in the Canadian parliamentary system
