

SAINT DUNSTAN BURSARIES

AWARD VALUE:

The Saint Dunstan's Bursary program provides bursary support each year for hundreds of Roman Catholic post-secondary students from the Diocese of Charlottetown who meet certain criteria.

An on-line application form is now available for the SDU Bursary program. Before applying on-line, please carefully read the criteria below to review your eligibility. Also, please ensure that you separately send— by mail— the additional required paper-based documentation.

Applicants for this bursary must meet the following criteria:

1. You must be an Island resident (have a permanent Island address), and must be graduating from a PEI high school with a grade 12 average of at least 65%, or must have achieved an average of at least 65% in your previous year of study.
2. An OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT must be sent to our office. (We will not accept a transcript that comes directly from the student, a transcript that is computer generated, or a transcript that is labeled "unofficial" by the university).
3. Those in university must qualify as full-time students (i.e. normally defined as a minimum of three courses per semester), and college students must attend on a full time basis.
4. Awards will not be made to students receiving other awards totaling \$5,000 or more (George Coles Bursary not included).
