

AGRO CO-OP EDUCATION BURSARY

GUIDELINES

The AGRO Co-op Association is offering two \$500 bursaries per year to students who have completed High School and who are entering the first year of post-secondary education at any Canadian university or college.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- (1) The applicant must have graduated from grade 12 to receive this award.
- (2) Applicant's parent or grandparent must be a member in good standing of the Agro Co-op in Charlottetown, and to have been for at least one year.
- (3) Acceptance at an accredited university or college. Cheque made payable to the university/college in the name of the student.

REQUIREMENTS

- (1) Bursaries will be awarded solely on the basis of a 250 to 500 word essay, on an agriculture related topic, that expresses the personal views and experiences of the applicant.
- (2) The Board of Directors of the Agro Co-op shall determine the winners.
- (3) Winning essays may be published by the Board in a newspaper or other media.
- (4) All essays submitted become the property of Agro Co-op
