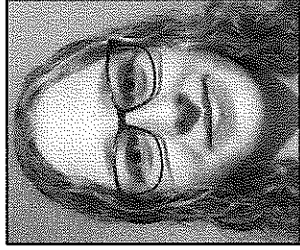

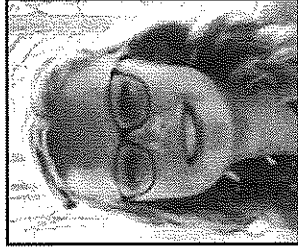

For 19 years, Niagara Region Right to Life has been organizing the Father Ted Colleton Scholarship program. The topics have varied over the years, but they have always challenged students to think more deeply about life issues and to write about them cogently. The prizes are awarded following an evaluation process conducted by a committee that assesses the essay-writing component. (Letters of reference and a demonstrated commitment to pro-life are also elements of the contest.)

One of Fr. Ted's favourite quotations was that from Edmund Burke: "All evil needs to flourish is that good men do nothing." He always called on the good young people in our society to do something instead.

Niagara Region Right to Life offers The Father Ted Colleton Scholarship essay contest as part of its mandate to reach out to society in an educational format. In particular, Niagara Region Right To Life wishes to help educate and inform the younger generations about the preciousness and possibilities of human life from conception to natural death and how certain threats affect those possibilities in its beginnings.
