WHAT DO PAGES DO?

- You will be responsible for the delivery of documents within the Chamber, the Hon. George Coles Building and the Legislative Annex; serving refreshments; photocopying and other responsibilities as assigned by the Speaker or the Clerks.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Students must write a 250 – 350 word essay on why you will be a great representative for Bluefield. Include knowledge of the position and what you think your duties will be. Interviews will be Thursday, October 15th. Students will be notified of their interview time.
