

SCHULICH LEADER SCHOLARSHIP

(This application must be processed by the Scholarship Committee)

AWARD VALUE: (\$80,000 – Engineering Degree or \$60,000 – Science, Technology or Math Degree)

The Canadian Schulich Leader Scholarships are undergraduate entrance scholarships for students intending to enroll in the STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) areas of study at one of 20 participating universities. (List of participating universities attached). This scholarship is for entrepreneurial-minded innovators outside of the medical community.

REQUIREMENTS

- The Nominee must be entrepreneurial-minded and plan to enroll in an eligible (STEM) program at one of the partner universities.
- The Nominee must be graduating from their high school in the 2020-2021 academic year
- The Nominee must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident
- The Nominee must meet at least two of the following criteria:
 - Academic excellence
 - Leadership, (entrepreneurial or community) charisma and creativity(entrepreneurial or community)
 - Financial need

APPLICATION PROCESS

- List of your top three achievements (academic or other) – 50 words maximum per achievement
- 600 word essay demonstrating why you would make a great Schulich Leader
- Optional essay to outline extenuating circumstances – 250 words
- Short answer to identify where they see themselves in 10 years – 50 words maximum
- Two single-page letters of reference that include email and telephone contact information for verification
- Copy of an up-to-date transcript, credit counsel summary or detailed academic report
- Headshot profile image for publicity
- List the name of the university/universities you wish to attend as well as what program you are interested in pursuing.
- Email address and phone number required.

Do not consider students who: focus on activism (environmental/political/societal), intend to become a practicing physician and/or medical researcher (e.g. Doctor, Dentist, Nurse, Psychologist, Pharmacist, Optometrist, etc., or intend to become a Professor and conduct theoretical research.

The above information must be submitted to Student Services by 12:30 pm on Monday January 11th, 2021.
